
## **APPLYING PREGLUED EDGING**

Edge banding is commonly used in home decorating. It is intended to help the user change the style and look of the grain in the wood. Eg. A plywood table can be changed to look like maple with the use of veneers and edge banding.

This leaflet details the application of edge banding


## **TOOLS REQUIRED**


- Scissors
- Iron
- Roller / block of wood
- Edge trimmer
- Utility knife





- Fill any large holes
- Sand rough spots
- Remove sawdust
- Cut edging 1.5cm longer than surface to be covered






APPLY EDGING

- Preheat iron on "cotton" setting
- Position edging
- Slowly press iron over length of edging
- Check to see if glue is melting. NOTE: Use utility craft paper or aluminum foil to protect iron bottom

## BONDING

- While still hot, press edging down firmly with wood block or roller.
- If mistakes should occur, simply reheat and reapply.



TRIM EDGE

- Allow edging to cool completely
- Trim excess with an edge trimmer or utility knife
- Sand wood veneer smooth and finish as desired.
